Dear G.R.A.B.,

Don't worry, he won't go far. Just give him a little room. You'll find him on your other side and a bit turned around. Now, if he turns up next to that other gal off to your side, that's a *Cross Run*, he's left you. But don't be cross, slide over and make room for the *new* guy! --Matilda

Dear G.U.F.F.,

Just realize that you aren't through when you hear "Swing" (which calls for a full turn in your partner's arms). The call may really be Swing Thru (a half turn by one hand, after which you may be through, or you may do another half turn by the other hand before you are through). Callerlab (aka the International Square Dance Caller Association) threw Swing Thru in there to mess with your mind. So, remember, for "Swing," don't swing, unitl you know that the caller is through. If he adds "Thru," switch to the one-handed half-turns until you are through. And, we're through here. --Matilda
